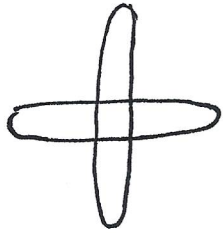

Ojo de Dios ~ "God's Eye"



start by wrapping a bright color yarn in the center.

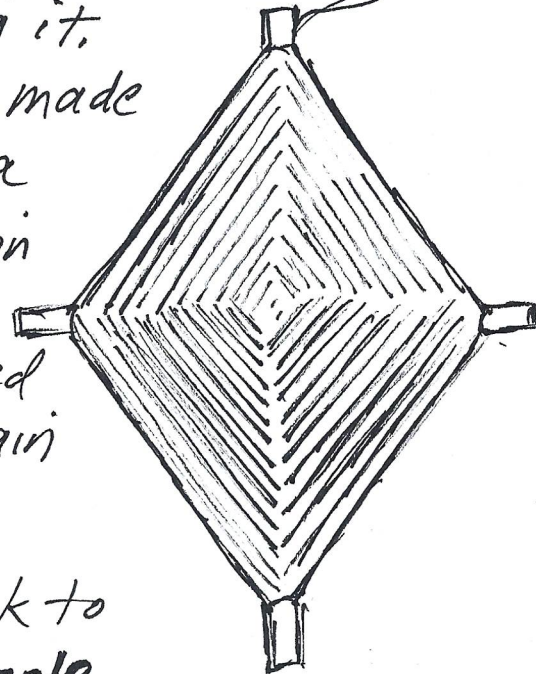
Connect pieces of yarn together by tying ends together. Carefully wrap the yarn around the sticks, following a pattern - over, under, over, under...

If you make a mistake or it doesn't look good, unwind the yarn and try again until it looks pretty.

Try to keep the knots on the back (unseen). Leave an extra piece of yarn at the end so that you can hang it.

"God's eyes" were first made in **Mexico** and used as a reminder of God's protection in homes, public buildings, outside where people worked and along roads and mountain trails.
