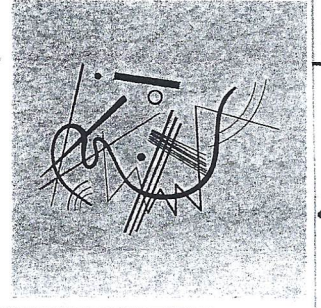

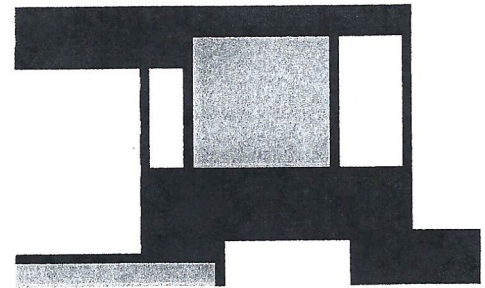
# Color & Modern Art



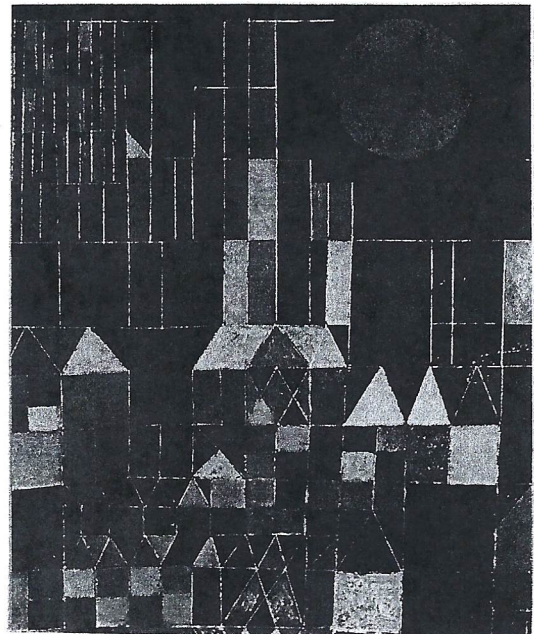

Modern Art refers to work produced from the 1860s to 1970s. It was a time of experimentation and a break from tradition. One form - abstract art - does not try to represent any image. Many artists used only colors & shapes to express feelings & ideas. Expressionism did present images but not realistically, people & things were distorted for an emotional effect. Cubism shows different angles or view points of an image - all at the same time. Impressionism is an art form that tries to give an impression of something without a lot of details - emphasizing light & movement.

**Make** a picture using the bits of color included. You can cut or tear in any shape and glue the bits onto the cardstock. You can also add words or images from magazines, newspapers or sales ads. Collage is an art form glueing many pieces together. You can also add string, ribbon, buttons... any found object. Have FUN & enjoy experimenting!
